






 P The fact that oil is bad for the planet is nothing new. But how does it measure up to the renewables? What is the long term viability of ethanol, biofuels, wind, solar, and hydrogen, and how does it compare with that of fossil fuels?/P

PThese are the questions asked by the nonprofit ProCon.org in its new website, [alternativeenergyprocon.org](http://www.alternativeenergyprocon.org). Its core mission is to find out whether alternative energy can effectively replace fossil recourses. For that the organization compared grid-generated power to hydrogen and fuel cells, weighed the benefits of nuclear energy, examined renewables and even looked into the pros and cons of the peak oil theory and researched known causes of climate change. /P
