INTRODUCTION

- * The research question you are addressing and your position/thesis on this issue

BODY of PAPER

- * The research process you used - what sites (ProQuest, EBSCO, etc) you used and chronicle the highs and lows of the research process - what worked, what didn't
- * Pick 3 sources (advanced level) or 2 sources (introductory level) from your research that support your position/thesis and discuss **HOW the source of information** supports your position (We'll outline a sample in class on April 21st)
- * Critique

CONCLUSION

- * What did you learn about your topic and how to formulate a good research supported thesis.
- * Draw conclusions about how easy/hard doing academic research is for you and what you anticipate will be your research needs will be in future terms based on what you learned on your exploration of your learning style and actually experiencing a research process -- this can also include topics for future studies, librarian/database support, strategies, etc.
