

Aim: To explore the meaning of being gay in today's world.

Motivation: students will take the heterosexual questionnaire and discuss results

1. Why are the questions odd?
2. Are these questions exaggerations or accurate?

Students will view Family Guy episode about Peter becoming gay and examine for tone. What attitude toward homosexuality is expressed in this episode? Provide examples for opinions.

Has our society become more tolerant and accepting of alternate lifestyles?

How many believe people can turn gay and then turn back?

Are people born with a gay gene?

Why (if religion does not play a role) do people find accepting homosexuality difficult?

Nature vs. nurture

Students will respond to the following:

if you knew you were carrying a gene for homosexuality, would you conceive a child?

If you found out you had this gene after conception, would you give this baby up for adoption? abort?

Students will watch Twilight of the Golds to explore this issue in depth.
