Course Objectives

There are three primary objectives of a World Studies course.

Objective 1. To provide the student with an understanding of events that have occurred in history, and for the student to be able to place events in the proper order in history.

Objective 2. To develop the ability to analyze events and series' of events, and to develop an understanding of reasons why events and trends occur.

Objective 3. To develop the ability to synthesize conclusions and predictions from past events.

There are several secondary objectives to the World Studies course.

The first is to provide the student with skills necessary for acquiring information from the internet.

The second is for the student to be able to write in several different formats. One format is to be able to use settings and trends to develop fictional (but historically accurate) stories. The second format is a report, in which a student will write a paper describing events or trends with a specific conclusion. The third format is a Document Based Question, or DBQ, in which the student will use primary sources to develop conclusions and hypotheses. The last is a research paper, written third quarter, which involves analysis and synthesis surrounding a specific series of events in history. The last secondary objective is for the student to develop a vocabulary which includes specific terms used in class.
