Website Evaluation Strategies

Authority

- Is there an author?
- Is there information about the author or sponsoring information?
- What is the domain? (.com= commercial, .gov=government, .org=nonprofit organization, .edu=educational institution)

Accuracy

- How does the information compare to information from other sources?
- is the text grammatical?
- Are there spelling errors?

Currency

- Is the date of creation or last update given?
- Are the links active?

Content

- What is the purpose of the site? Can you tell?

Objectivity

- If the site deals with controversial issues, is the viewpoint clearly stated?
