For this classroom-based assessment: In a cohesive paper, you will 1. **State a position on the issue that considers the interaction between individual rights and the common good AND includes an analysis of how to advocate for your position.** 2. **Provide reasons for your position that include: a) an analysis of how the Constitution promotes one specific ideal or principle logically connected to your position on the issue. b) An evaluation of how the Constitution was upheld by a court case OR a government policy related to your position on the issue. c) A fair interpretation of a position on the issue that contrasts with your own.** 3. **Make explicit references within the paper or presentation to three or more credible sources that provide relevant information AND cite sources within the paper, presentation, or bibliography.**
