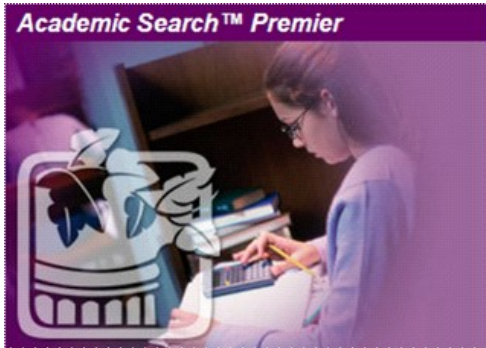

**Academic Search Premiere** (ASP): ASP contains thousands of articles from popular and academic journals. The database includes peer scholarly journals and popular mainstream publications like Scientific American, Time and U.S. News and World Report.

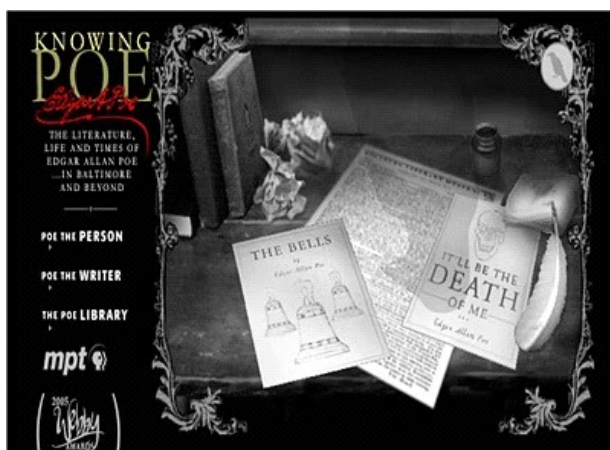

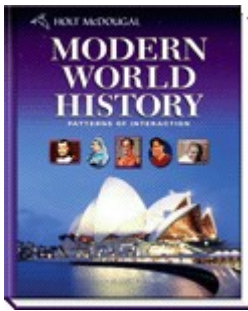

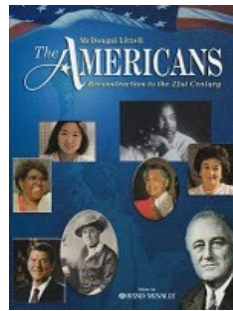


If you have a Class Zone account then just get the textbook activation code from your English teacher.

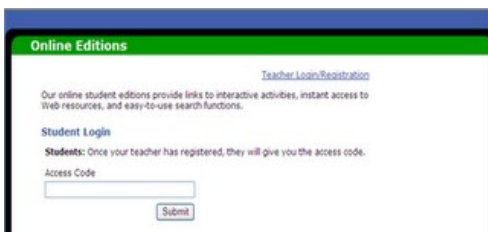
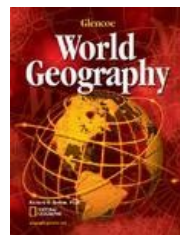

2. Type in the access code for the textbook. Ask your teacher or the school librarian for the access code.

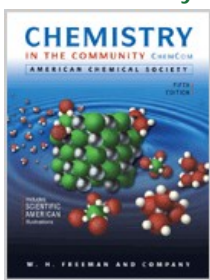
