Key terms for the course

Attendance 10% Attendance & participation (15 classes, 10 points a day)
Attendance in class is expected and you should come prepared to discuss the materials assigned and to participate in class discussions. Much of the learning will arise from the interactions within the classroom environment in large and small discussion groups and in writing workshop. Your peers will depend on you as much as you will depend on them which makes your presence in class valuable and imperative. You will be given daily credit for attending class and for participating. Falling asleep, reading the paper or doing else something off task is not considered participation. You are permitted to have three hours (1 class period) of unexcused absences without penalty (additional absences will result in losing complete participation points for that class and in-class work cannot be made up for credit). For any and all absences, you must collect notes and turn in your work that was due on the following class day. If a major assignment is due, it must be submitted the same day by whatever means necessary (e.g., via the Internet, hand deliver). Major assignments include papers, group presentations or projects. Please be sure to contact me for short-term absences due to illness, bereavement or authorized university activity, etc (a computer printout from the self-service cold clinic at Pechan Health Center is not appropriate documentation.). Excused absences are those where the student gives the instructor a doctor's note for illness or a flier or memo for a school-related activity such as an open house or a back to school night. Conference presentations may also count as an excused absence. All other types of absences are considered unexcused. Unexcused absences drop one letter grade off of your total participation grade for the class. If you miss more than the equivalent of three weeks of class (3 class periods) for any reason (excused or unexcused), you will receive an F for the course. No extra-credit will be offered to make up for absences. *Absence is not an excuse for being uninformed: you are responsible for any and all information presented at class meetings.
