<http://www.zamzar.com/> - Zamzar enables users to type in a URL or upload a file from their computer. It then converts the file to another format. Users then receive an email giving them another URL from where they can download the converted file. *In simple terms – this site allows you to save Youtube and other videos found on the Internet for use in your multimedia production.*

<http://www.mailbigfile.com/> - Some students email projects to themselves to work on between home and school. Many production type files quickly get too big to email as attachments. This service will upload your file and email you a URL from where you can download your large file.

<http://www.voki.com/> - Create lifelike avatars. This site helps you create personalized animated characters that will speak using your voice, your candidate's voice (if you upload the sound file), or the computer generated voices available on this site.
