**Pro/Con & Point/Counterpoint -- Print Resources**

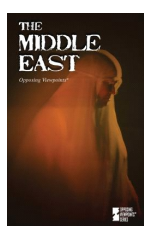

The following are just some of the books in the URC that provide an introduction to events surrounding the Iraq Conflict. A more complete list of topics covered is provided in the URC.

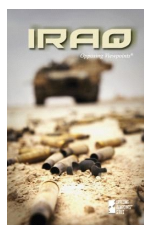
