Google search your novel title & specific terminology (criticism, historical influences). Read various sites for background knowledge (even Wikipedia perhaps), but remember that you can only cite academic sources in your paper. Academic source = reliable source & credentialed author. You might use a source like Wikipedia to collect information regarding the general view of a work, but you can't cite Wikipedia since authors are not listed & no credentials are given. You can use Wikipedia's resources & reference links sometimes to track down more reliable information.
