CINAHL	<i>Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature</i> provides journals from the fields of nursing and allied health in legal cases, clinical innovations, critical paths, drug records, research instruments, and clinical trials. CJPI Criminal Justice Periodicals Index	Provides information on virtually any criminal justice topic, including corrections, administration, law enforcement, social work, industrial security, drug rehabilitation, and criminal and family law. Computer Source	Provides researchers with the latest information and current trends in high technology. This database offers full text for more than 300 publications and abstracts for nearly 450 publications.
ERIC	ERIC, the Educational Resource Information Center, provides access to education literature and resources.
GreenFILE	GreenFILE offers well-researched information covering all aspects of human impact to the environment. Its collection of scholarly, government and general-interest titles includes content on global warming, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling, and more. The database provides indexing and abstracts for more than 384,000 records, as well as Open Access full text for more than 4,700 records.

Created by the National Library of Medicine, MEDLINE uses MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) indexing with tree, tree hierarchy, subheadings and explosion capabilities to search citations from over 4,800 current biomedical journals. Military & Government Collection	Designed to offer current news pertaining to all branches of the military and government, this database offers a thorough collection of periodicals, academic journals, and other content pertinent to the increasing needs of those sites.
